Dan F. Gray — "Demo Soft Pastel from Life" 10:00 AM — 2 hours

Dan Gray has 36 years painting pastel from life, living through painting. Dan will entertain and inform you with his humour and demonstrations.

Bill Helin — "Transforming through Cultural Mythology" 1:00 PM — 1 hour

Bill Helin is a Tsimshian/Norwegian artist specializing in many different mediums of cultural art. His art work tells stories through the transformation of Native animal Life Crests, using two and three dimensional art and video.
